WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON'S COLLEGE'S NEW RESIDENCE HALL SURPASSES HALFWAY DEVELOPMENT MARK

July 15, 2002 – Pittsburgh, PA -- Washington & Jefferson College in Washington, Pennsylvania has reached a development milestone for Phase I of its new residence hall, a 45,000 square foot dormitory, which will house 93 students and offer additional space for a residence area coordinator, office space, and common areas.

Arranged in suite-style accommodations with provisions for 15 additional students, the four-story building honors the classical character of W & J while providing modern conveniences.

“This residence hall represents the first phase of an on-campus housing development at the East Beau and North College Streets site. The college’s master plan envisions a second phase to include academic learning facilities and the capacity to house 118 additional students,” stated Arthur R. Ruprecht, AIA, Vice President of RSH Architects, designers for the project.

Construction of the new residence hall began in November of 2001 with accelerated site development. The building is scheduled for completion on August 30, 2002. Mistick Construction is the general contractor.
